Immigrant Services Outcomes

835 Legal consultations

439 cases filed

5 legal teams and 100+ volunteers



Education Outcomes

A total of 114 students were awarded scholarship assistance amounting to \$171,000.

No Mas Clinic Volunteer

A total of 5,900 service hours have been logged, amounting to a value of \$197,591.

Financial Assistance Provided

44 individuals received \$38,000 for government filing fees.

Student Volunteer Hours

2,400 service hours have been logged, amounting to a value of \$80,376

Student Demographics

Represent 14 countries

Community Engagement

200 households surveyed with a total of 598 family members
60 one on one appointments connected families to resources
4 out of 10 reported dental pain resulting in \$13,000 in financial assistance for dental care



Youth Program Outcomes

50 youth participated in a six-week intensive program centered on English phonics, grammar, reading, and digital skills.

Emergency Assistance



110 households received support for housing, transportation, and healthcare, amounting to \$126,000

Food Pantry Numbers



A total of 6,257 individuals have been served, contributing to a monetary value of \$74,257.

Play & Learn

Over 30 moms, attended the class and received diapers, amounting to a value of \$8,900

VITA Clinic



328 tax returns were filed totaling \$519.00 in refunds and 1,800 volunteer hours from students at University of Utah & Ensign College
